What can you do as parents/carers?

When you try to help, there's an argument (at best).

 Act as a gobetween, asking the questions of school which your child can't or won't

Ensure they eat well, get sufficient exercise and enough sleep Practical advice: stick sheets in books, find any gaps, check understanding...to make revision easier. Any gaps check with teacher

Before the revision starts help plan....

A timetable

- Break it down into manageable slots
- Plan treats, breaks, fresh-air
- Make sure they are up-to-date in your subjects
- Make a list of subjects to revise and break each one down into chunks
- Set realistic targets
- No distractions-no phone calls/no texts/facebook/twitter
