What you will be assessed on

Assessment in Drama at KS3 is ongoing and students are assessed in each lesson through making and performance.

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How you can support at home

Discussing key skills and how to use them.

Look for characterisation examples in TV and film.

Look for and analyse excellent examples of character in TV and Film.

Look at a range of comedy and consider which elements make us laugh and why.

Look for examples of slapstick comedy such as Monty Python.

Discuss satire and look at examples such as Spitting Image.

Look for examples of different styles and genres of performance to watch and discuss.

Discussion around the topic and what your child has learnt.

Discussing the story of Dr Faustus with students and reviewing how they have performed this.

Explore the seven deadly sins and why they are still relevant to society today.

Discuss the war in Syria with students.
