Autumn Term

Topics being taught

Theories of crime: functionalism, Marxism, labelling.
Theories of religion: functionalism, Marxism, feminism; religion & social change.

OCTOBER 1/2 TERM

Crime: realism; crime control & prevention; ethnicity & crime.
Beliefs: secularisation, religious renewal, fundamentalism, globalisation.
