

Subject	A Level French
Context	The grammar tasks are to recap key work on tenses from GCSE and the tasks about the film (Amélie) are to prepare you for the A Level work on essay writing about films and literature. Materials are provided in paper form/on Showbie and copies of the film on DVD will be loaned from the MFL department.
Securing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spend time practising the key verbs Quizlet set : quizlet.com/43916593/as-french-important-verbs-flash-cards • Ensure you have a clear understanding of past, present and future tenses. You can use the 'Practice makes perfect' grammar book on Showbie to find clear explanations.
Processing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete some past, present and future grammar exercises from the above grammar textbook – mark your answers using the answers at the back. • Film study – pre-film activities: complete pages 2-35. These activities will give you a very good understanding of the context, characters and locations within the film before you watch it.
Exploring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watch the film at least once! • Complete the rest of the activities in the booklet – here the work will allow you to demonstrate your understanding of the film and give you opportunities to analyse.
Reviewing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • VOCAB: review the 2 vocab lists (la famille / la musique) – these will be the first two topics you study in Y12 and this is the vocabulary you will be tested on throughout the half-term. Make a start on learning this during the summer. • Go back and check your work before handing in. If necessary, make a note of anything you have been unsure about/want to double check with your teacher in September.
