These activities will give you a very good understanding of the context, characters and locations within the film before you watch it.</li> </ul>
Exploring	<ul> <li>Watch the film at least once!</li> <li>Complete the rest of the activities in the booklet – here the work will allow you to demonstrate your understanding of the film and give you opportunities to analyse.</li> </ul>
Reviewing	<ul> <li>VOCAB: review the 2 vocab lists (la famille / la musique) – these will be the first two topics you study in Y12 and this is the vocabulary you will be tested on throughout the half-term. Make a start on learning this during the summer.</li> <li>Go back and check your work before handing in.
