Students should arrive at school via the entrance gate located on Arthurs Avenue or Otley Road and proceed to the Astro Turf (located to the left of the school building). Staff will be on hand to guide students. Please note, school buses will not be running during this week.

We assume that all students have parental permission to walk home at the end of the day. If this is not the case, please email [mail@hgs.rklt.co.uk](mailto:mail@hgs.rklt.co.uk) with the name of the student plus the name and contact phone number of the person collecting them. Students can be collected from the Astro Turf. The main car park will be open if you are driving to school.

**Lunch** Please bring a packed lunch into school for these 3 days. Please note we are a nut-free school.

A break will be scheduled in the morning and students are welcome to bring a snack.

Packed lunches will be provided for any students entitled to a free school meal.

**What to wear** As students will be taking part in a range of activities including sports, creative tasks using paint, felt pens and glue, alongside team building events, we recommend students wear clothes that are comfortable and that they do not mind getting a little dirty. They will need sensible shoes e.g. trainers.

**Equipment** Each day students should bring with them:

- School bag containing a pencil case (2-3 pens, pencil, eraser, ruler)
- iPad on days 2 and 3 (if you received your iPad on Tuesday 27 August)
- Refillable filled water bottle
- Snack for break

**iPads** Students will be issued with their iPad during the summer school, and we will be showing them how to set this up ready for learning.

For those not able to attend summer school, our iPad co-ordinator will email you to arrange a suitable time to collect.
