






Books that go Bump in the Night

Set in the 17th century, a breathtaking debut, and a potential prizewinner, about the power of women, witchcraft, fury, revenge and the ties that bind us.


After witnessing the brutal murder of her mother by witch-hunters, Evey vows to avenge her and track down the killers.

Twice filmed as The Haunting, and the inspiration for a 10-part Netflix series, The Haunting of Hill House is a powerful work of slow-burning psychological horror.








In a shabby house in the new capital of Madrid, Luzia Cotado uses scraps of magic to get through her days of endless toil.
